Note:

Previously unknown work by Paul Signac that is not documented in the Signac Archives, Paris.

An entry in Hildebrand Gurlitt's address book suggests that he was personally acquainted with the Chachin-Signac family, the artist's descendants. It is conceivable that Gurlitt may have purchased this sheet watercolour directly from the family. Per Signac's granddaughter, Françoise Cachin, all records pertaining to sales to German collectors and art dealers were lost during the war.

This work features on a list titled *Großer Koffer* which was drawn up by Cornelius Gurlitt on 11 November 1989.

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
