Note:

Signac created hundreds watercolours, most of which were never documented. Owing to the lack of images or other detailed comparisons, this makes an identification in early publications almost impossible.

The watercolour could not be proved in literature, databases, documentations of museums and a large number of auction catalogues as yet.

An entry in Hildebrand Gurlitt's address book suggests that he was personally acquainted with the Chachin-Signac family, the artist's descendants. It is conceivable that Gurlitt may have purchased this sheet watercolour directly from the family. Per Signac's granddaughter, Françoise Cachin, all records pertaining to sales to German collectors and art dealers were lost during the war.

A reference to a Signac watercolour titled *Viadukt* can be found in the correspondence of Hildebrand Gurlitt. It was sent to a restorer in December 1947.
